Day 1 October 17, Saturday: Depart USA

Depart from New York (JFK) or Chicago (ORD) for our pilgrimage to Poland. Dinner, breakfast and beverages will be served on board. (D,B)

Day 2 October 18, Sunday: Welcome to Poland! | Czestochowa

Arrive at Krakow International Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way tour manager as we exit Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus and we will be on our way to Czestochowa (2+ hours). A stop will be made en route for an independent lunch. Upon arrival in Czestochowa, we will celebrate Mass at Jasna Gora, the Paulite Monastery and largest Marian shrine in Poland, home to the miraculous "Black Madonna." After Mass, enjoy a guided visit of the monastery, with its Chapel of the Virgin, where the sacred icon is kept for veneration by the faithful. We will also visit the beautiful Basilica of the Holy Cross and the Nativity of Mary, with its magnificent Baroque altar depicting the Assumption of Our Lady into Heaven. Tour the Monastery's 600th Anniversary Museum housing offerings from the prisoners of the Nazi and communist concentration camps. The treasury houses many votive offerings left by pilgrims, including those given to the monastery by St. John Paul II. Check-in to our hotel and freshen up for dinner.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Czestochowa.

Day 3 October 19, Monday: Highlights of Krakow

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning we'll board our comfortable touring bus for Krakow. Upon arrival we will visit the Basilica of St. Mary (Mariacki). Celebrate Mass and see the noon opening of Europe's largest Gothic wooden altar, built by sculptor Wit Stows in the 15th century from gilded linden wood. Independent lunch.

We'll continue in the footsteps of St. John Paul II in Old Town to visit Kanonicza Street, where he resided while living in Krakow. Explore the courtyards of the Collegiums Maius. Visit the Franciscan Church where Fr. Wojtyła loved to come and spend quiet time in prayer. Pass the Archbishop's Palace to see where Fr. Wojtyła attended the seminary, was ordained, and lived as a Cardinal. Continue to Wawel Cathedral, the burial place of all but one of the Polish kings. St. John Paul II offered his first Mass here in the Crypt of St. Leonard. Climb the steps of the bell tower to see the largest active bell in the world. Check-in at our hotel in Krakow.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Krakow. (B,D

Day 4 October 20, Tuesday: Auschwitz | Divine Mercy Shrine

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, depart Krakow for Auschwitz. Upon arrival we will have a guided tour of the Concentration Camp and Museum, including "Auschwitz II" at Birkenau. Auschwitz is known as a Nazi death camp, having executed over 4 million people—mostly Jews—during World War II. It is also the site of martyrdom for St. Maximilian Kolbe, who willingly offered to die in a stranger's place as an act of Christian charity. Edith Stein, or St. Theresa Benedicta, also died here as she stood up for the lives of others, as did so many others. Time will be given for reflection and prayer. Independent lunch.

Return to Krakow to visit the Divine Mercy Shrine, dedicated by St. John Paul II during his last visit to Poland in 2002. We will tour the Divine Mercy complex, including the original burial site of St. Faustina. **Celebrate Mass at the shrine.**

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Krakow. (B,D

Day 5 October 21, Wednesday: Krakow Jewish Quarter | Wieliczka Salt Mines

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will visit the Jewish Quarter, Kazimierz, the center of Jewish life in Kraków for over 500 years, before it was systematically destroyed during World War II. In the communist era it became one of Kraków's dodgiest districts while gradually falling into disrepair. Rediscovered in the 1990s, thanks to the fall of the regime and worldwide exposure through the lens of Steven Spielberg, Kazimierz has rebounded and is today Kraków's most exciting district—a bustling, bohemian neighborhood packed with historical sites, cafes,

and art galleries. Well-known for its associations with Schindler and Spielberg, traces of Kazimierz's Jewish history have not only survived, but literally abound in the form of the district's numerous synagogues and Jewish cemeteries. In fact, no other place in Europe conveys a sense of pre-war Jewish culture better than Kazimierz. As a result, the district has become a major tourist draw and pilgrimage site for Jews, which has led to the return of contemporary Jewish culture in the area. Independent lunch. In the afternoon, we will tour Wieliczka and witness the oldest salt mine in Europe. Wieliczka is a unique place where many generations of Polish miners have created an underground world of underground salt lakes, with a rich interior of decorated chapels, including the famous Blessed Kings Chapel, plus other galleries and workings made of salt. Enjoy a guided tour of the Salt Mines. Celebrate Mass at the Chapel.

Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Krakow.

Day 6 October 22, Thursday: Wadowice | Kalwaria

Feast day of Saint John Paul II

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning we'll depart for Wadowice, the birthplace of St. John Paul II, born Karol Józef Wojtyła on May 18, 1920. Our guided visit of Wadowice includes sites associated with St. John Paul II. The family house at 7 Koscielna Street has been turned into a museum with exhibits of Wojtyła family's former possessions. See the parish church where Karol Józef Wojtyła was baptized, confirmed, served as an altar boy, and prayed daily before its miraculous picture of Our Lady of Perpetual Help. This is a wonderful opportunity to imagine the childhood of Karol Wojtyła and reflect upon the circumstances in history and the culture that shaped his character and prepared him for the priesthood and papacy. Celebrate Mass at the Wojtyła family parish church. Independent lunch.

After lunch, we will visit the Calvary Sanctuary in Kalwaria Zebrzydowska. When Karol was eight years old, his mother died, and his father took him to Kalwaria, a Marian shrine close to Wadowice. Karol's lifelong devotion to the Virgin began on that trip after he lost his mother. The shrine was established to provide pilgrims with a substitute of Jerusalem lost to the Muslim Turks, and thus unavailable for veneration. With its 42 churches and chapels of all shapes and sizes in addition to the central basilica and the Franciscan monastery, the vast complex of buildings grew to be the biggest such compound in Europe. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Krakow. (B,D)

Day 7 October 23, Friday: John Paul II Center | Free Afternoon in Krakow

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will visit the Church of The Lord's Ark (Kościół Arka Pana), a remarkable building and symbol of the Polish belief in Catholicism. The first corner stone was laid in 1969 by Cardinal Karol Wojtyła and was pieced together brick by brick by volunteer workers with no assistance from the communist authorities. On May 15, 1977, the church was consecrated. Built to resemble Noah's Ark, with a 30-foot mast-shaped crucifix rising from the middle, the church houses an array of interesting treasures, including a stone from the Tomb of St. Peter in the Vatican. Continue to the John Paul II Center. See the octagonal lower church dedicated to John Paul II, known as the Church of the Relics (Kosciol Relikwi), decorated with vividlycolored images depicting events from the pontificate of Pope John Paul II and his visits to the world's most famous Marian sanctuaries. The centerpiece of the shrine is a simple marble altar in the middle that contains a vial with the relic of the blood of St. John Paul II displayed in a glass case. Celebrate Mass at the John Paul II Center.

Independent lunch. Free afternoon in Krakow.

An optional bus transfer to/from the Divine Mercy Shrine will be provided for those who wish to return to the shrine this afternoon.

Festive group dinner at a restaurant in Krakow.

Overnight at our hotel in Krakow. (B,D)

Day 8 October 24, Saturday: Return to the USA

Very early morning, we will be transferred to Krakow Airport for our return flight to the USA.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If a final payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: The \$350.00 tour deposit is non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury. Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. All service charges and local hotel taxes are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave €1 Euro per person for the wait staff after each meal and €1 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.
